Rescinding the Curfew for the Town of West Warwick

WHEREAS, the primary goal of municipal government is to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens;

WHEREAS, EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-7 IMPOSING A CURFEW for the Town of West Warwick was issued based upon potential threats against property within the Town;

WHEREAS, upon advice of the Colonel of the West Warwick Police Department, the Town Manager has determined that the curfew established by EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-7 can be rescinded at this;

WHEREAS, a future curfew may be ordered upon receipt of credible information to regarding potential threats against person or property within the Town of West Warwick.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ernest Zmyslinski, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Town Manager of the Town of West Warwick, pursuant to the Rhode Island General Laws and the Charter and Ordinances of the Town of West Warwick, including but not limited to Title 30, Chapter 15 of the General Laws and including but not limited to Section 308 (G) of the Charter of the Town of West Warwick, and the Declaration of Emergency approved by the West Warwick Town Council, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-7 imposing a curfew for the Town of West Warwick shall be rescinded.
2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
