


Centerville Road Bridge Detour



What's Happening?

RIDOT is rehabilitating the Centerville Road Bridge, which carries Route 117 over Route 2 in Warwick. The next phase of this project requires a temporary detour for eastbound traffic only. Access to local businesses will be maintained.

Route 117 eastbound traffic coming from West Warwick will be detoured down Quaker Lane and connect to Bald Hill Road via Ginsu Way. The next off-ramp will return motorists back to Route 117 at the light adjacent to Dunkin Donuts.

When is it happening?

This detour pattern will be in place Monday, February 18 and will continue into mid-summer. By detouring traffic, RIDOT can complete the bridge work six months faster than originally planned so construction can be finished by the end of 2019.
